2. Application must be accompanied by a letter from the college verifying student's registration and that it is their first year in College.

3. The scholarship is open to students who are members of Enniscorthy Credit Union.
4. Payment of 2nd and 3rd elements of bursary in this competition will be dependent on:
 - i. Student maintaining satisfactory progress in the course they are doing; or
 - ii. If the initial course is only a two year duration that they continue on to the next level on the National Framework of Qualifications.
5. The student entered in the draw must be either present at the holding of the draw, or be represented by a family member at the holding of the draw. Otherwise the entry will be disqualified.
